Dates & Times:

- Starts February 21st through April 13th, 2024
- Every Wednesday (4:00-5:30 or when finished with their games)
- Please be at the Super Bowl 5-10 minutes early to get your shoes, bowling ball, etc. as we will start bowling at 4 p.m.

Post Season:

- We will choose 5 boys and 5 girls for teams to represent TLC/LTC for the postseason.
- Sectionals will be April 13th and TBD on the location.
- If the teams or any individuals advance to the state finals, we will schedule more practices for the advancers only.
- Student athletes will have a bowling shirt that they will wear and be expected to wear at each and every meet. When the season is over, they will be expected to return this shirt to athletic director/coach.
- State will be April 19th and 20th.
- More details on sectionals and state will be handed out later.

Prices

- The students/parents are responsible for paying for bowling.
- The schools will pay for any bowling matches, sectionals and state.
- \$42 will be due at the first practice, which pays for 4 practice sessions and includes shoes, a bowling ball of the rack to use, shoes and 3 games per session.
- Example: \$42 will play for practice on 2/21, 2/28, 3/6 and 3/27.
- Make check payable to IV Superbowl.
- You can pay ahead to make it easier if you would like, but you must be paid up to be able to bowl. You can't catch up next week. No exceptions.
- Sectionals and state will be paid for by the athletic co-op.

Misc:

- Parents can stay if they would like but are encouraged to NOT stay. This helps the kids stay focused on bowling and learning.
- If we have any meets with another school, we will replace a practice with the meet. I will let everyone know if we do so parents can then come and cheer on the kids.
- Dress code for practices will follow the same dress code at Tonica Grade School for game days. If we have a meet, we ask that they wear their game day team shirt and nice pants or skirt. (NO jeans or sweatpants).
- We understand some kids might have other sports overlapping with the bowling season. Communicate with us as we can work through it and kids will not get penalized for it.
- If you are wanting to get your own bowling shoes, balls, etc. you can schedule a time at the Superbowl counter with Dan Shepard to get them ordered.
- The counter will have water they can drink and they can get drinks out of the vending machines. No eating will be allowed while bowling.
- NO use of cell phones is allowed during bowling.
